# **PRO - Paint Remover**



### **Description:**

Paint Remover is a heavy-duty viscous Coating Remover. It's based on methylene chloride with some other solvents and surfactants to improve penetration of stripper which enable the painter to remove all types of coating like high bake Polyesters, Acrylics, Epoxy, 2K Paint system and Cellulose based system. Paint Remover is non-flammable and guick acting product without affecting the bared surfaces.

# **Product preparation - Application**



It is strongly recommended to use appropriate personal protection equipment during application to avoid respiratory, skin and eye irritation.



Spread a heavy layer evenly over the surface.

**N.B:** Scratching or sanding the finish will often speed up the stripping action.

Repeat the application if necessary.

Keep lid closed between applications.



Leave for approximately 10 -15 minutes until paint or coating has softened.



Remove Paint with metal scraper, Steel wool can be used in difficult areas.

Wipe the scraped surface with water to remove any excess remover.

Allow the surface to dry.

**Shelf life:** 6 Months in good storing conditions (25°C, 60% humidity). Applying outside this range may impact finish.

#### Remarks

- Be careful when opening the can.
- Don't inhale, breath or touch to skin or eyes.
- Ensure there is maximum ventilation during application.
- Wear safety glasses and gloves.
- Keep out of reach of children.
